Student Identification Card

At the beginning of the freshman year, students receive an ID Card from the Office of Student Affairs. A student should always carry the ID Card and present it during examinations or when he enters the library

Student Organization

The Dong Seoul Students Organization, made up of all students attending the University, aims to train the students to be democratic citizens, improve their critical thinking, and make a contribution to the development of the University. The major activities students perform are as follows:

research and academic activities
various activities to refine emotions
welfare works for students
athletic games and festivals
volunteer work for the community and the nation
other activities pertinent to the aims of the student organization

Student Clubs

When a student wishes to establish a club, s/he should submit the following documents to the Office of Student Affairs:

Application for Club Registration

The club leader's name, members' names (30 students at least), and the name of one professor guiding the club

List of activities planned Student organizations or clubs may hold any activities which are not harmful to the academic atmosphere, lectures,

research or the performance of the University's basic functions. Students may post printed materials under the name of their organization.

Guidance For Student Life

All students at Dong Seoul University have a department-appointed faculty advisor who helps the student with student life, academic programming, extra-curricular activities, and the development of his/her University life. Each student must meet his/her faculty advisor on a regular basis.

Orientation

Freshmen Orientation A one-day orientation is held by the Student Organization during registration and the first week of classes. Activities

such as library tours and information sessions on a variety of subjects, services, school facilities, and extra curricular clubs are organized.

Department Orientation All members of a department including professors and assistants, senior students, and freshmen make a two-night

and three-day trip to esort areas. Freshmen are instructed how to lead a successful University life by professors and the second year students getting acquainted with one another.

Scholarships

In order to assist qualified students whose academic record and conduct qualify them for a scholarship or who may be unable to continue their education because of financial difficulties, the University provides a number of scholarships at the beginning of each semester. The need for financial assistance must be justified.

Kinds of Scholarships for Which Students May Apply: To qualify for a scholarship, a student must have earned at least 20 credit hours

the previous semester and attained a GPA of 3.0 or more.

- Full scholarships for the two top students in each department.
- Partial scholarships for the next four or five top students in each department.
- Sons and daughters of meritorious persons will receive a partial scholarship if the student has maintained a certain level of credits and GPA.
- Scholarships for student body representatives.
- Scholarships are granted to qualified students with financial difficulties.
- Sons and daughters of professors and staff of the University will receive a full tuition scholarship if admitted to Dong Seoul.
- Alumni Scholarships: Provided by the Dong Seoul Alumni Association.
- Scholarships from outside the University: Provided by business enterprises, foundations, and individuals.

Application for Scholarships A student who needs a scholarship to continue academic studies must submit an application to the Office

of Student Affairs during the designated period each semester. Those who qualify as meritorious persons must submit, in addition to the

application form, a certificate testifying to the status of the meritorious person.

Scholarship Cancellation if a student who receives a scholarship takes temporary leave, voluntary permanent withdrawal, or is expelled the scholarship for the pertinent semester is cancelled.
